## **Castle Museum Receives 2020 MCACA Grant**

**SAGINAW, Mich.** – The Castle Museum of Saginaw County History has been awarded a \$20,000 operating grant from the State of Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs (MCACA). The grant was evaluated through the MCACA peer review process and awarded for the MCACA 2021 fiscal year.
