Jazz on Jefferson Celebrates 15th Annual Festival

SAGINAW, Mich. – Classic cars, music, food vendors and thousands of people will line Saginaw's historic South Jefferson Avenue for the 15th annual Jazz on Jefferson event Wednesday, June 6.

This one-night celebration attracts more than 3,000 visitors and counting each summer. The festival kicks off with a performance by the Saginaw High School drumline at 4:45 p.m.

Festivalgoers can enjoy a variety of activities such as: food from local vendors, a classic car and motorcycle show, Hoyt Library's hospitality tent, free carriage rides and so much more. The Castle Museum will also feature its popular strawberry shortcake.
